### Result 3

#### Supporting ASEANstats

ASEANstats brings together the statistical services of the ASEAN secretariat and serves as a catalyst in the harmonisation process. ASEANstats capitalises on the Programme's input to enable the production, compilation and dissemination of higher quality data in three of five statistical fields: in the international trade in goods and in services, and in foreign direct investment. EASCAB also supports ASEANstats in managing the harmonisation process and developing a strategy for the ASEAN statistical system.

### Result 4

#### Developing Relevant Statistical Products

The Programme makes statistical products available that facilitate data dissemination and promote the use of international trade statistics for goods and services, and foreign direct investment in ASEAN economic integration policies and programmes.

### Result 5


#### Building an Interactive Regional Database

The Programme is building an interactive regional database to allow the rapid exchange of information across ASEAN. The goal is to have the database operational for international trade statistics for goods as well as for other relevant fields by January 2013.

### Result 6

#### Facilitating Regional Integration

The sixth and final result of EASCAB is to make statistical data from the European Union and the ASEAN member states more comparable. This allows analysts in both the EU and ASEAN business communities to more precisely analyse opportunities for enhanced cooperation. Study visits to Europe foster an exchange of experience and create networks for healthier international cooperation.
